The teaching method at the Shri Ganesha school is based on three pillars:

1. Quality of education

Our ambition is to offer high-quality primary education. We are renewing our teaching methods constantly. Digital education, focus on the English language and additional guidance for pupils who have extra needs, are important elements in our approach. Small scale classes allow us to focus on pupils individually. A high end test score – of course within the capacities of the child – is important to us.

2. Discipline, structure and respect

Discipline, consistency and respect are important values within our school. Trust between the teacher and pupil ensures a good atmosphere and an optimal learning environment. Appreciation and respect for each other and the surroundings contribute to positive results. The school stands up against fighting, bullying and other inappropriate behavior.

3. Values and norms of Hinduism

Hinduism is a philosophy of life that seeks meaningful connections within and out of ourselves. Values such as tolerance, equality, non-violence and openness are essential.
